Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada – Subspecialist Examination Affiliate Program (SEAP)



1 Who?



- Internationally trained subspecialist in Canada who's primary specialty is not certified by the RCPSC.
- **Have obtained Royal College Subspecialist Affiliate Status through RCPSC**

2 Steps?



- 1) Apply to the RCPSC
- 2) Granted eligibility to write the subspecialty exam
- 3) Pass the subspecialty exam
- 4) Obtain Royal College Subspecialist Affiliate Status

Please Note: the steps above must be completed before qualifying for licensure. You are only eligible once you have obtained Affiliate Status.

3 Preconditions?



There are no preconditions.

Once the RCPSC exam is passed, you may obtain Royal College Subspecialist Affiliate Status.

4 Policy?

5 Certificate Type?



Restricted scope-defined certificate of registration.
For example, Dr. X may practice independently in pediatric cardiology.

6 Eligible for CPSO License?

- 2) Under [exam eligible policy](#) if you are missing the Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada (LMCC)
